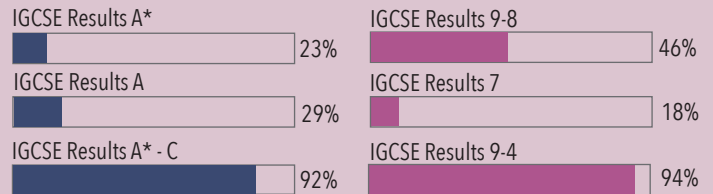

We offer GCSE or IGCSE qualifications which are graded 1-9 / G-A*. All students must take English Language, Mathematics and Science.

SIS RESULTS 2024 (%)



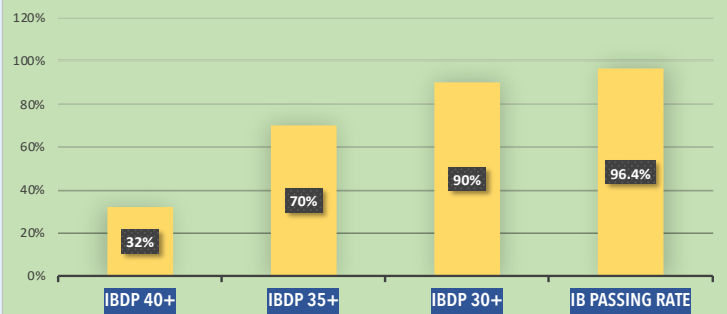
SENIOR SCHOOL CURRICULUM (YEAR 12-13)

Our Senior School students have a choice of the IB Careers Related Programme (IBCP) or the IB Diploma Programme (IBDP). IBDP students will typically select one offering from each of the six groups which are graded 1-7. We predict TOK/EE points based on predicted grades in the other six subjects. Students scoring 40 and above are predicted 3 points. Students scoring 30 to 39 are predicted 2 points. Students scoring 29 or below are predicted 1 point. They are also required to take an appropriately challenging language course. About 10% of our students embark on the IBCP. Many students choose to do more than the IBCP minimum of 1 BTEC Programme along with 2 SL IB certificates. The BTEC is graded from Distinction* (D*) to Pass (P). Our Individual Needs students take on a personalised curriculum that suits their abilities and needs.

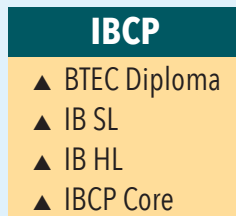
